The Fund is managed by MC Square S.A. (the **Management Company**)

Objectives and Investment Policy

Objectives

This actively managed Sub-Fund aims to achieve capital appreciation.

Investment policy

The Sub-Fund seeks for investment opportunities across global markets and different asset classes mainly investing in UCITS and other UCIs.

The Sub-Fund invests from 25% to 75% of its Net Assets, directly or indirectly, in Equity Securities.

The Sub-Fund may also invest up to 10% of its Assets in Contingent Convertible Bonds.

The benchmark of the Sub-Fund is composed of 50% Bloomberg Barclays Global Aggregate (LEGATREH Index PR EUR) and 50% MSCI World EUR (MSERWI Index PR EUR). It is used as a universe and for performance fee calculation. The fund manager is not constrained to replicate the benchmark.

The Sub-Fund may invest into financial derivatives instruments for hedging or investment purposes.

The recommended investment horizon is at least five (5) years.

Specific Information on the shares

You can request the sale of your shares on a daily basis, except in certain circumstances (see prospectus).

No dividends are intended to be distributed. Any income derived from the portfolio is reinvested.

This USD share class is hedged against the Sub-Fund's currency, EUR.

ESG Policy

The Sub-Fund does not promote environmental or social characteristics, nor is it classified as a product that has sustainable investments as its objective.

Definitions

Actively managed: the manager has total discretion over the composition of its portfolio, subject to the stated investment objectives and policy of the UCITS.

Debt Securities: securities representing a loan that the issuer must repay with interest.

Equity Securities: securities representing an ownership interest held by a shareholder in a corporation.

Derivatives: securities whose characteristics and value depend on the performance of one or more underlying assets, such as debt or equity securities, indexes, interest rates.

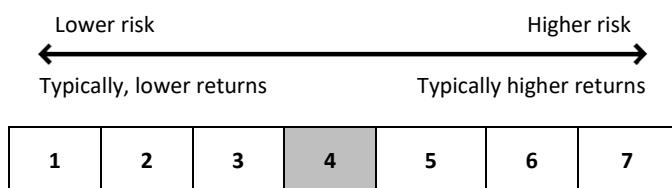
Hedging: a technique to reduce exposure to specific risks such as price, currency or interest rate fluctuations.

Contingent Convertible Bonds: Hybrid debt instrument issued by a financial institution with an embedded option.

Benchmark: a standard index, or composite, against which the performance of the Sub-Fund is compared.

UCITS, UCI: Undertakings for Collective Investment in Transferable Securities (UCITS). Undertaking for collective investment (UCI).

Risk and Reward Profile



Meaning of the risk and reward indicator

The risk indicator aims to provide you a measure of the price movement of the shares. This category 4 means that the share price has an average price movement therefore the risk of loss as well as the expected reward can be medium. The lowest category does not mean a "risk free" investment.

Reason why the Sub-Fund is classified in this risk category

Fund volatility corresponds with the investment strategy.

The following risks may not be fully captured by the risk indicator and may be materially relevant for this Sub-Fund:

Counterparty risk: the risk arising from the inability of any party contracting with the Fund to satisfy its obligations, in particular in respect of off-exchange financial transactions where the market does not guarantee the performance of contracts in case of defaulting counterparties.

Credit risk: the risk arising from the inability of an issuer of Debt Securities to pay interests or repay the sum borrowed under the Debt Securities.

Hedged Strategies risk: the risk arising from improper hedging (e.g. when hedging insufficiently reduces the loss of capital or significantly reduces the potential rate of return of the investment hedged).

Equity Securities risk: the risk involved in holding Equity Securities in a particular company and whose value may decline as a result of the underperformance of such company or of external factors affecting the company such as economic, political or market changes.

The ongoing charges figure is based on expenses for the year ending 31 December 2020. This figure may vary from year to year.

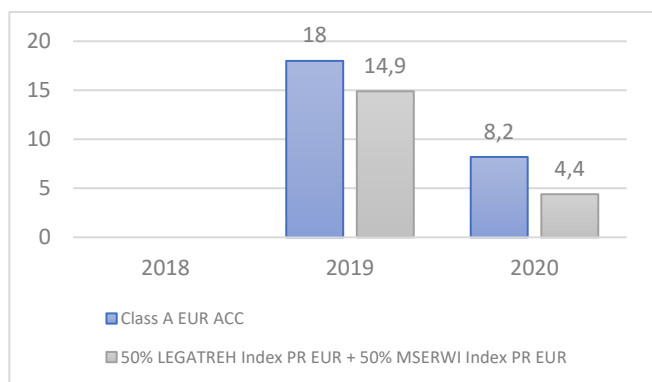
Ongoing charges do not include the following:
